ZOE is a distinctive three-year program, developed in Africa that empowers orphans and vulnerable children around the world to overcome extreme poverty, become fully self-reliant, and learn of God's love for them. ZOE has approximately **28,000 children** currently enrolled.

In three years or less, these children are so empowered that they no longer need our support. Children who have completed the program often reach out in ministry to other children in their community who are suffering. In this way, the program has a ripple effect, transforming lives beyond the original working group.

Beginning on Ash Wednesday, we challenge you by doing less during Lent, you can help vulnerable children fulfill God's dream for their lives.

Many people choose to give something up for Lent, often small luxuries like coffee, chocolate or fast food. ZOE is asking you to take it one easy step further – save the money you would have spent and use it to help orphans build a new life, free from poverty.
