Pastor's Corner

We have been very busy around here!! Of course that is nothing new for Perritte. The autumn weather brings much work for our annual bazaar. The bazaar requires a great deal of hard work to make all the pieces fit and for a successful day! Our chairperson, Becky Byars, like others before her, has a giant binder that gets updated each year; each process, each department, each detail carefully logged and kept safe so that there will be no hitches, no missed elements on her watch. It takes a small army of dedicated servants to make this event happen. But in working together, we also have fun!

We have had a very full month of opportunities for outreach to our neighbors. It was wonderful to meet our local police officers and firemen at the National Night Out event on October 6! We had a couple of neighborhood folks stop by and share the time with us, too. Last Thursday, we were so glad to be able to have fun with the students and families and the faculty at Nettie Marshall!! Even though rain threatened to spoil the fun, the weather held off until later that night! And this Saturday, we will gather in our parking lot for the annual Trunk or Treat Event! Rain is in the forecast as of press time, but I am praying that it holds off for the many events of the day!!

On the 18th, we had our Church Conference and took the vote about the prescriptions we received from the Vibrant Church Initiative. The VCI process requires churches have a 75% affirmation to proceed. Our count was 72% in favor and only two votes shy of adoption. That same afternoon we had our annual Charge Conference with our quad churches at Wesley Foundation. Our district superintendent spoke of many congregations making a difference in the communities they serve. It is difficult to capture in a meeting the real stories of transformation that take place in people's lives through interaction with the Body of Christ. But the stories need to be heard and told. Perhaps we need a binder full of grace-filled stories that will continue to remind us of God's presence in the past and to guide us in our uncertain future. Faith is about remembering and knowing...that which we cannot yet see.
