This past summer, several families in our church committed to give beyond their usual tithes to the church to support a ZOE Working Group in Kenya. Our Church received an end of the year update on our Tumaini "Hope" Micii Mikuru Working Group which shares,

"This first year has been filled with hard work and great progress." ZOE has guided the children down paths of discovery and they have learned: they possess strengths and talents that will enable them to overcome their disadvantages, that they are someone of value who can contribute to the community, that they do not have to face their challenges alone, and that God has not forgotten them. Already the children are becoming food secure and starting their first income generating activities."

During March, each member of the group planted maize provided by ZOE on their individual farms. Because the rains were very good, the harvest was good. Below, you can see the Working Group gathered together to help individuals weed their maize farms.

Guatemala Mission Trip

Mark Dalhoff will soon be going on a mission trip with Grace Avenue UMC to Guatemala to work at a project called God's Child. Founded in 1991, the God's Child Project cares for and educates 5,000 orphaned, abandoned, and poverty-stricken boys and girls in addition to providing health and community – based services for 8,700 widowed, abandoned, and single mothers and their dependents in Guatemala, El Salvador, India, Malawi, and the United States. The mission team is attempting to raise \$8,722 to buy school supplies for the 350 children that attend school there. They are also trying to purchase two bunk beds (@\$220 each) for the two houses that they will build while they are there.
