## Pastor's Corner: Conferences

This Sunday we will have a called Charge Conference at Perritte. In the United Methodist tradition we use the term conference for our official meetings. The charge conference is a meeting of the charge, which is our church, Perritte Memorial. A charge conference is made up of members of the Church Council and the pastor and is usually presided over by the District Superintendent or other authorized elder in the connection. We will take a vote for a new way of organizing our leadership as required by our *United Methodist Book of Discipline*. The Committee on Nominations and Lay Leadership will also submit a new slate of officers for the proposed Board of Stewards and a revised list of ministry teams.

Methodists have long been known for our meetings. The word conference was adopted as the denomination was coming to be. We have conferences at all levels of our church, divided geographically. We are part of the East District in the Texas Annual Conference. The Texas Annual Conference is one of five annual conferences within the boundary of Texas. It is also connected in the United States in the South Central Jurisdictional Conference, which will meet in July for the election of bishops. Then we will learn the name of our new bishop. (It is in the Jurisdictional Conferences that Bishops are elected every four years, a quadrennium.) Each quadrennium, the whole church assembles for a ten-day General Conference. Delegates are elected from laity and clergy in their home annual conferences. General Conference is happening now in Portland, Oregon.

Next Sunday, May 29, the Texas Annual Conference begins meeting in Houston. Annual Conference is always a very busy time and one of great worship, great fellowship and some wonderful learning. On Monday evening, we will gather to celebrate our Bishop's retirement, effective August 31, 2016. Bishop Janice Riggle Huie has led the Texas Annual Conference through many needed changes in our organization and in our direction for developing disciples and a vision for calling young pastors and planting new churches. Please join me in prayer for our conference and the transition to a new episcopal leader September 1. We will also welcome a new District Superintendent on July 1...some of you already know him, he was your pastor many years ago—Rev. Tony Vinson.

## **Charge Conference**

This Sunday, May 22, immediately following worship, we will have a called Charge Conference of our elected leaders to approve a new way of organizing our administrative committees. Our committee on Nominations and Lay Leader Development began studying the single -board model last August. Like other churches of our size, we often struggle to fill the traditional administrative committees as required by our Book of Discipline and also fill our ministry teams. After careful study and discussion, a sub-committee was established to come up with a detailed structure for approval at our Church Council meeting on April 3, 2016. The Council voted unanimously to approve the change.

We will vote to approve the formation of a Board of Stewards, made up of 12 church members who will serve as the finance, trustees, and SPRC. (There are copies of the approved proposal in the church office or we can send them to you by email.) A Charge Conference (elected members of the current Church Council and the Pastor) is required to make this change of governing our local church. A charge conference must be announced at least 10 days prior to the meeting. If you have questions, please contact Chris Bouldin, council chair, or Pastor Lani.
