Perritte is once again partnering with Nacogdoches ISD for the Summer Meal Program, what we call Pioneer Park Ministry. **This Monday-Friday**, Perritte volunteers are hosting the program at Pioneer Park (501 Leanwood), under Shari Locke's leadership. We will organize games, crafts and other fun activities between 10:45 am and lunch (11:45 am). The kids will eat lunch and leave no later than 12:45 pm.

In addition to volunteers to work from **10:30 am** to **1:00 pm**, we will be responsible for providing a "**Weekend Sack**" designed to provide food over the weekend for those that have none. We are seeking small individual servings of non-perishable items, easy to open, pop-top or pull tabs. Suggestions include:

vienna sausages, soup, fruit cups, chips, fruit roll ups, crackers, spaghetti with meat balls, raisins, granola bars, trail mix, and Chex mix.

We need approximately 8-10 items per sack for an estimated 35 children. Please bring your donated items to Memorial Hall by **Thursday**. "Sacks" are welcome too!

Perritte Community Arts Program

Music and Arts have been a tradition in the Christian faith since David played on his harp, so we believe the church is a natural place to nurture arts education for children. Seeking ways to connect with our neighborhood and live into our mission field in Nacogdoches, Texas, we recognized that there was a deficit of affordable music and arts education for children. In its initial model, the Perritte Community Arts Program will be an after school program with a three stage rotation of group piano, ukulele, and art for up to thirty students between third and fifth grades. Students will be offered transportation, quality instruction, and a small snack for a nominal fee. Keeping the cost low will help us attract the students who are hungry for a creative outlet; however, lack the funds for private instruction–perhaps the next Mozart who never would have been found because his parents could not afford the high cost of private instruction.

The children we are trying to reach are in free and reduced lunch programs through their school district. Our goal is to make this an affordable arts academy by providing scholarships for the majority of students. We believe that children are creative beings and need high quality arts opportunities, regardless of their ability to pay. Already having funding sources in place for initial costs, the program is currently seeking additional grant opportunities so that



it will be fully self-sustaining.
It is an exciting opportunity of outreach to our community, offering things that perhaps never would have been attainable.
