My Preparation for Easter

Lent is a time to prepare for Easter. It is a necessary prelude. The death and resurrection of Christ are true whether or not I prepare for Easter. However, without my heart and life being ready, I may not experience the depth and power of Christ's death and resurrection. "Discipline" was never a favorite word of mine...yet during the time called Lent, we are invited to discipline our spiritual lives: devote time to Bible study and prayer, spend time with God in silence listening for His directions, add some commitments to servant ministry to your calendar, make some calls and reach out to heal some old relationships... The Board of Discipleship has some suggestions for helping each of us be more intentional during these forty days of preparation before Easter arrives. Read the list below. Pray that God would help you thoughtfully and seriously respond. Then check the ones you desire or feel prompted to do; circle the ones you then are committed to do.

Inward and Personal Disciplines

- ____ Spend time alone with God each day in silence.
- ____ Read a book for inner growth.
- ____ Read through the gospels that the stories for the next few weeks come from Matthew and John.
- ____ Begin to keep a journal of prayer concerns, questions, reading.
- ____ Focus on thanksgiving, rather than on asking, in prayer.
- ____ Give myself a gift of three hours to do something I always say I don't have time to do.
- ____ Make a list of people with whom I need to be reconciled. Pray for them and let Jesus guide me in my thinking and feeling toward them.
