Thanks be to God for two very successful weeks of ministry to

children during the month of June! We began with five days of ministry at Pioneer Park, June 12-16, where we provided Bible teaching, crafts, and "weekend food bags" to over 30 children. Ray Stoner's wood cut craft projects and the ice cream sandwiches that we took on Friday were the highlights for



the kids. The smiles and relationships that we built with the kids were my favorite part.

Then, on Sunday the 18th-Thursday the 22nd, we hosted a to-



tal of 43 children for VBS. We had lots of children from the neighborhood in attendance, as well as children and grandchildren from our own congregation. It was noisy, a little chaotic at times, and totally AWE-SOME! The children's mission project this year was to bring change each night in support of our ZOE kids'

working group. They brought \$225.00 in four nights!

I want to thank EVERYONE who supported these ministries with their time, their talents, their prayers, and with financial donations. Please continue to pray for the children who attended at Pioneer Park and at VBS. Seeds were planted during these two weeks.
