Lent will be here next week. Lent is the season of preparation before Easter and as you may already know consists of 40 days (not counting Sundays). Traditionally we focus on fasting and prayer. Fasting can be from anything, not food alone, that separates or distracts our time spent with God in prayer and discipleship. Sometimes, instead of fasting, disciples have taken on a new Spiritual practice for the Lenten season, perhaps clearing out a bad habit and making way for a better one.

This year you are invited to join me by using the book

40 Days with the Holy Spirit by Jack Levison,

WJA Power Professor of Old Testament Interpretation and Biblical Hebrew at SMU Perkins School of Theology. We are going to set aside time each day to read a scripture passage, a meditation and spend a time of reflection. The book has a space for writing your reflections. We will gather on Wednesdays, beginning on February 21, at your choice of two times, **noon** and **6 pm**, to discuss what we've discovered through this intentional Spiritual practice. On Sundays, the sermons will focus on one of our weekly themes.

They say that a new habit can be formed in 40 days...let's do this together and see what we discover and hear from the Holy Spirit. Books are available in the church office for **\$12.50** each.
