



Dear Perritte family,

It is with sadness that I inform you that Susan Teekell our Administrative Assistant at Perritte will be leaving her position as of May 31, 2019. The good news is that the Teekell family will continue to attend Perritte and Susan will continue to volunteer in our educational programs.

We are currently seeking to fill the position with someone who is not a member or participant of our Perritte congregation. The Board of Stewards agrees that it will allow confidentiality of members when in pastoral counseling, and it increases trust. It will also prevent the overlap of congregation members trying to conduct "business" with the Administrative Assistant on Sundays.

The position begins on May 16th for a two week training with Susan before she leaves her position. This is a parttime position of 25 hours per week, Monday through Thursday.
