Pastor's Corner

Christ has risen! Christ has risen indeed! These are exciting words on the lips of every Christian at Easter. As we count down the days until we celebrate our risen Savior, we remember his last days on earth in human form. Holy week takes on this journey.

There are so many traditions in our Christian faith during Holy week. We have Palm Sunday/Passion Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Foot washing, Tenebrae, Good Friday, the Seder or Passover meal, The Stations of the Cross (Way of the Cross), Easter Vigil.

This year we will have a very busy and memorable Holy Week. Palm Sunday will begin with the triumphal march at our morning worship service; at 6:00 pm, we will enjoy the beautiful cantata "It Is Finished" which incorporates a Tenebrae service, describing the passion of Christ, his journey to his crucifixion.

If you miss the passion of Christ on Palm Sunday evening, you will have an opportunity to experience it in a different way on Good Friday with the dramatic presentation of "Silent Witnesses". This dramatization of the beating, crucifixion and death of Jesus Christ is narrated by the items involved in these events: the Scourge, the Crown of Thorns, the Nails, the Robe, the Sponge, and the Spear. A very memorable and haunting finish to our Holy Week.

Easter Sunday we will have one service at 10:30 am. We will not have Sunday school on Easter; instead, we will share breakfast together at 9:00 am with free family photos and activities for the children. Invite family, friends and neighbors to celebrate with us!

Easter also begins a new worship series entitled, "Just As He Told You: When in Doubt, Read the Instructions". This series will begin on Easter Sunday and concludes on Pentecost Sunday. This Easter season we will encounter teachings of Jesus that end up coming in handy as the early church struggles and thrives... ultimately handing on the instructions to us. What will we do with them?

I hope you will support as many worship experiences as possible. Please continue to keep our leadership team in your prayers for wisdom and guidance as we make decisions for the overall health and mission of Perritte.
