It is easy to become so involved with recitals, tournaments, graduations, weddings, the end of school and other events during the month of May, that God and the church take second place in our lives. Please do not let this happen to you and your family.

As you look at your May calendar, plan today, ways in which you and your family can find time to worship. If you are attending events out of town, search now for another church or churches you can attend to worship God. Please remember to bring back a worship guide which is counted toward your perfect attendance award! As you seek churches to attend, if you cannot find a church service at an appropriate time, then consider online streaming and television options. (Ask Pastor Carol if you need assistance to find online church services or Pastors, who preach biblical truths.)

Internet and television are options, however, worshipping in person with a group of believers is more beneficial to you and the other believers. Taking time to plan for worship should be included in your travel and vacation planning.

In our last worship series, during the Lenten season, we devoted time to developing spiritual practices. It is my expectation that you have already developed this as a daily habit. Finding time one-onone time with God should be included in your summer plans, too.
