Pastor's Corner

Many of us are convinced that summer is already here with all the high temperatures, humidity, severe thunderstorms, tornadoes, hail and severe allergies and that all happened in May! What can we expect in the month of June?

I cannot answer that question. But I can tell you that with graduations complete, school out, some of our church family already taking vacations and going on adventures near and far from home, it is already summer for Perritte Memorial.

Perritte Memorial UMC does not take summer vacations. We are here in the office Monday through Thursdays 9-1, and we are here every Sunday offering Sunday school to all ages, fellowship time, and worship. We incur expenses for utilities, paper goods, office supplies, maintenance costs, employee salaries, and this an abbreviated list of all our expenses. Church family, Bishop Scott Jones, our bishop of the Texas Annual Conference, gave the newly commissioned and ordained candidates a challenge as they pastored their churches. He discussed the 5 core values of Methodist Hospital Houston, which expects ALL employees from the doctors down to the person who empties the trash to implement daily. He made it clear that this was a challenge for all clergy as well as laity. Here are the 5 "ICARE" values:

As your pastor, I accepted this challenge on behalf of Perritte. I would ask that through prayer and reflection, you write down or email me your thoughts and reflections of examples of the ways the people of our church exhibit **integrity**. I will update our church family weekly, how many responses I receive, and I will relate to you some of the examples I receive. You might first start with looking at yourself and your integrity and then look at it from our church as a whole. **The challenge begins with this newsletter.** Are you in? I want very much for Perritte to be able to say that we are an **ICARE** church.

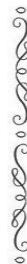
